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A Contestant's Report from IMsL 1995

Thursday, July 22, 1995

The Leather Archives and Museum is dedicated to the collection and preservation of leather history. Because so much of our history has been underground, concealed from the public, from our families, and even our friends, most of that history has not been documented. Much has already been lost. AIDS is causing more historical loss than ever before. It is essential that we preserve a record of our lifestyle and, as with any minority community, that we do it ourselves.

The Leather Archives and Museum was formed in 1992 for that purpose. Incorporated as an Illinois not-for-profit corporation, initial storage space has been secured and donations are being accepted. The search has begun for: a permanent building, professional advice and assistance from historians, archivists, conservators, and librarians, and the needed equipment and funds.


