

She also produces Dreams to Reality, which is a weekend BD/SM/Leather Event geared towards novices. She also travels to do workshops, judge contests and teach safe, sane & consensual. Susan has been a member of the leather community since 1992, but played the games for years before she found the community. She trained as a slave, became a switch, mentor and now is Daddy to a wonderful #1 boi, deb and a wonderful girl, flower.

KATHRYN ALEXANDER

Kathryn has played an active role in the New Mexico Leather community for many years. She represented New Mexico through the title of Ms. New Mexico Leather 1999 and, along with her husband leads the educational and social outreach project known as AEL. Kathryn has also been involved in the presentation of many workshops, with topics ranging from SM 101 to Bondage on a Budget. Kathryn was a driving force behind the formation of a series of free monthly BDSM workshops known as AEL Power Munch.

STAN ALEXANDER

Stan has been involved in the Leather / SM lifestyle for over 15 years. He, along with his wife Kathryn, has taken on a leadership role in the New Mexico community, with his efforts to produce outlets for education and social interaction, through a group known as AEL (Alternative Erotic Lifestyles). In addition Stan has presented workshops on a large variety of topics both locally and outside of NM. Relevant to the workshops he will be presenting this weekend, Stan earned his Masters in Counseling from the University of Texas and holds certifications as a Clinical Hypnotherapist and Neuro-Linguistic Programming Practitioner.



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AMBER/SPIDERLILY

Amber has been an out leatherdyke for 30 years. She lives in northern New Mexico. During a 12 year sojourn in Seattle, she studied artistic cutting, and has given workshops there, most recently at the Wicked Womyn Conference in October 2003.

PAT BAILLIE

Born and raised in California, Pat left behind the sun and surf to serve in the US Air Force until 1993 when she retired as a Major. Pat now lives in Albuquerque, New Mexico where she is a corporate trainer and is working on starting her own acupuncture practice having just been licensed as a Doctor of Oriental Medicine.

Pat first connected with the leather community back in 1979 while stationed in Phoenix, Arizona. The now disbanded Phoenix Levi and Leather club were willing to open their hearts and show this budding pervert the ropes. chains, whips, whatever. The key for them was service - fundraising and having a good time. She continued to work in the background of leather events while on active duty and was able to see not only traditional leather life but also what was new and growing around the country. Once the military prying eyes were gone, Pat decided to become a more public leader in the leather community and use all those organizational skills she had been trained in for a higher purpose. She held the title of Ms. Leather Master 1995 and Ms. San Jose Leather 1995. Winning in Chicago at the first International Ms. Leather (IMsL) contest produced by Amy Marie Meek/Bare Images, gave Pat the opportunity to act as bridge between the first 9 and the next 5 IMsLs and gain a deeper understanding of the worldwide leather communities. IMsL also provided the chance to build networks that worked to organize local and nationwide programs for feeding the hungry, youth, combating domestic violence and getting political through LeatherWomen United. She was Pantheon of Leather's Woman of the Year in 1997 and part of Couple of the Year in 1999.

Pat has also worked with many mainline GLBT groups to breakdown stereotypes and get over our own internal _____-phobia (fill in your own blank). Pat has spent much of her leather journey as a bottom/boy but now has found her Daddy/Sir space with Kate, her girl. In the rest of her life, she is the co-President of Albuquerque Pride, produces a weekly TV show for Emmanuel MCC and is actively involved with many other groups on the local, state and national level.

JOE BEACH

Born in New Orleans, I grew up in six different states and Puerto Rico before coming out in leather in 1982 at The Anvil & Spike in Manhattan. A member of New Orleans' NLA Chapter in the 1980's, I performed the 2nd Leather number ever at Petronius' Mardi Gras Bal Masque in 1990. An Austin resident since 1994 and volunteer at our HIV Wellness Center since 1995. I've emceed and participated in events that have raised over \$20K for HIV/AIDS Direct Service Organizations. Since becoming a titleholder, I write the column "South By South Plains" for Leatherpage.com. I am currently Mr. South Plains Leather 2003, Mr. Austin Leather 2003 and am the owner/producer of the Mr. Austin Leather Contest.

LORI CAMPBELL & JAIME NEMITZ

New to Albuquerque, but not new to the scene. We have been presenters at numerous Leather runs in Texas: Beyond Vanilla (X&XI); South Plains Leatherfest (I) as well as Texas Leather Pride. Individually and together, we have done numerous workshops for clubs like: NLA Dallas; NLA OKC; EROS; Different Strokes. We have served as chair persons & hostesses for the Dallas Women's Discussion Group (a monthly meeting of women who lived "alternative lifestyles")...and volunteered at countless runs and parties as Dungeon Masters and in countless supporting roles.

Among the programs we have presented in the past: Vaginal Fisting; Leather & Spirituality; SM 101; Getting started in the lifestyle (literally, coupled w/ a more vanilla version of SM 101); Pervertibles; Polyamory; Kinky Crafts; Leatherwomen's Roundtable. Our current community-building project is the Sandia Women's Dinner, a monthly dinner-discussion group held in Albuquerque.

KATE CHAPMAN

Kate Chapman was born in Italy and grew up as a Navy Officer's daughter. She settled in New Mexico in 1970 and fell in love with her life partner in 1977. Kate was sure she had invented the leather lifestyle, and she used her knowledge of the military, early Gorean writings, and the Internet to structure her leatherwalk starting back in 1976. She continued to live out her leatherwalk in the privacy of her home for years, and she identifies mostly as a Top. In 1992 she began connecting with the New Mexico leather community. She entered formal leather training in 2001 with Pat Baillie as her Daddy/Sir and is travelling with Pat on the leather circuit bringing her experience and passion to the leather community.


Major has practiced impact play for 25 years and taught locally in Albuquerque as well as out of the state. He has attended events and presented seminars nationally for many years.
